The [STAR² Center](#) (Solutions, Training, and Assistance for Recruitment and Retention), the workforce project of the [Association of Clinicians for the Underserved \(ACU\)](#), released updates to the [individual health center recruitment and retention Data Profile Dashboards](#) the week of June 29, 2020. The Profiles are a blend of public, private, and proprietary data and thus access to these interactive tools were shared only with each health center's CEO via direct email. These Data Profile Dashboards form the base of the STAR² Center's resource building, training, and technical assistance (TA) efforts by highlighting individual health center strengths and weaknesses, as well as national health center trends in recruitment and retention. The Profiles previously existed in a static PDF format. Since 2019, the Profiles have been integrated into a Dashboard format allowing health center staff to review their updated data in an interactive format with their workforce teams, comparing their current and past data, and their data against the average data of other similar health centers.
